COURSE DESCRIPTION

This highly engaging qualification is ideal for those considering a career or looking to improve their position within the resources industry.

PREREQUISITES AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no formal entry requirements, however, it is preferred that participants have some experience in the resources industry.

This qualification can complement and enhance your existing skills, knowledge and qualifications. It can equip participants with the skillset to be more effective in leading and managing organisations in today's complex environment.

COURSE DELIVERY

Gold Training delivers flexible training with instructor's who have extensive industry experience. Gold Training offer this qualification:

- via an on-the-job traineeship over a 12 or 24 month time frame
- face-to-face over 12 days
- throughout locations across regional and remote Queensland, New South Wales and Western Australia

VOCATIONAL OUTCOMES

This qualification reflects the responsibilities of an employee in the resources industry including mining and quarrying. Participants will obtain a broad range skill set from risk management, communication, first aid, basic vehicle operations and work health and safety awareness.

As an employee you will often be required to use discretion and judgement in decision making to ensure a safe working environment and preparedness in the event of an emergency.

COURSE FEES

Course fees may vary depending on the units you are enrolled in so an approximate amount has been shown based on Gold Training's standard unit selection. You will be given the exact amount of your fees at enrolment. Part time student fees will vary depending on the number of units you are enrolled in.

- face to face - \$3,800.00 (negotiable upon larger group enrolments)

Course fees are made up of two components: tuition fees and resource fees. Tuition fees are determined by multiplying the nominal hours, which is the number of hours in which an average student could be expected to complete the qualification. They are not the hours of training or instruction. Resource fees are charges for material that are essential to a course or unit, and are purchased by Gold Training to be used by students during the course.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL)

Gold Training recognises that you may have skills or knowledge from previous learning or work experience, you may be eligible to apply for Recognition of Prior Learning and/or Credit Transfer towards partial completion of this qualification.
