## COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Generic Induction Coal Surface Refresher [GI Refresher] program has been developed as part of Gold Training's on-going commitment to the quality of training, education and safety in the coal mining sector.

The Generic Induction [GI] Refresher course is for anyone working in Queensland in the coal mining industry and is also a crucial qualification for those looking to enter the mining industry.

The GI program provides training and assessment for the Resources and Infrastructure Industry (RII) Units of Competency which are specified in Recognised Standard 11, Training in Coal Mines [Qld Coal Mining Safety and Health Act 1999].

The units of competency within this course can be used towards completion of more advanced training courses and qualifications such as RII30115 Certificate III in Surface Extraction Operations.

## COURSE OVERVIEW

The GI program [sometimes referred to as 'Standard 11'] is a requirement for any worker in the Queensland coal mining industry. This compulsory course is run in accordance with the recognised Standard 11 for training in coal mines.

The purpose for this course is to refresh participants to the following components of the mining industry:

- overview of general mining practices
- Qld coal mining legislation
- risk management
- isolation and tagging procedures
- traffic and mobile equipment procedures
- first aid and emergency procedures, including first extinguisher training
- accessing and understanding site procedures

## COURSE DELIVERY

- face to face over one day

## UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER (USI)

From 1 January 2015, participants undertaking nationally recognised training require a USI before they can receive their training records and results. Once a USI is created participants will continue to use their USI for any future nationally recognised training they undertake.

Your USI links to an online account that contains all of your training records and results that you have completed after 1 January 2015.
