COURSE DESCRIPTION

This highly engaging qualification is suitable for those interested in a career or employment in the civil construction industry.

This qualification reflects the role of a skilled operator working in Civil Construction, who applies a broad range of skills in a varied work context, using some discretion and judgement and relevant theoretical knowledge

The qualification applies to specialist occupations within the civil construction industry.

PREREQUISITES AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no formal entry requirements, however, it is preferred that participants have some experience in the civil construction industry.

COURSE DELIVERY

VOCATIONAL OUTCOMES

Participants will obtain a broad range skill set from work health safety, communication, planning and organisation skills and use hand and power tools.

As an employee you will often be required to use discretion and judgement in decision making to ensure a safe working environment and preparedness in the event of an emergency.

COURSE FEES

Course fees may vary depending on the units you are enrolled in so an approximate amount has been shown based on Gold Training's standard unit selection. You will be given the exact amount of your fees at enrolment. Part time student fees will vary depending on the number of units you are enrolled in.

Course fees are made up of two components: tuition fees and resource fees. Tuition fees are determined by multiplying the nominal hours, which is the number of hours in which an average student could be expected to complete each unit. They are not the hours of training or instruction. Resource fees are charges for material that are essential to a course or unit, and are purchased by Gold Training to be used by students during the course.
